Tuesday of this week, August 15th, is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary into heaven, a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be celebrated at 6:30 am and 8:30 am at St. Teresa, 3:00 pm at the Covington Care Center and 7:00 pm at Immaculate Conception, Bradford.

I have had one person, so far, volunteer to help with the Nursing Home Mass, which will take place once a month on the third Tuesday of the month. I hope others, who are able to, will prayerfully reconsider volunteering. We all value the opportunity to participate in Mass on Sunday, do people of our parish and other areas now residing at the Covington Care Center desire it any less?
