From the desk of Father Duell:

Today is World Mission Sunday, and we recommit ourselves to our common vocation to be missionaries through prayer participation in the Eucharist and by donating generously to the Collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. This year, Pope Francis addresses his message to us as we live out our baptismal call to be sent forth to bring the Gospel to the world. All Christians have received this mission and we trust that God gives us the grace to live it out wherever we may be. In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our baptism. We have the opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized in more than 1,111 mission dioceses.

Pope Francis, in order to animate the missionary transformation of church life and pastoral activity, has asked each country to highlight a great missionary who shared their life for the love of the Gospel. Here in the United States, we have chosen native Daytonian and martyr of Brazil in 2005, Sister Dorothy Stang, SNDdeN. Sister Dorothy was killed because of her defense of the indigenous Brazilian people and the environment.
