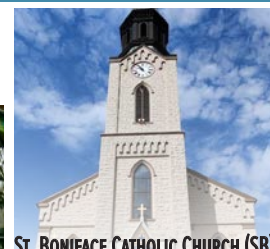

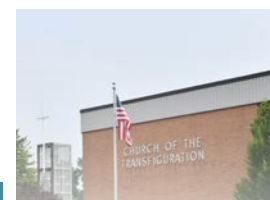

PARISHIONER CONTACT INFO: Be sure to keep your address, phone number and e-mail up-to-date with your registered church, so you don't miss important things.

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Behold, the Lamb of God

In today's Gospel, we hear John the Baptist proclaim, "Behold, the Lamb of God." This phrase is John proclaiming Jesus as the Messiah. This is an important phrase that we echo at every Mass, where the priest presents the Eucharist to the people identifying Jesus as the Sacrificial Lamb who takes away the sins of the world and inviting believers to recognize Him in the Bread and Wine before receiving Him in Holy Communion. It also points to His presence and power for salvation, echoing Old Testament sacrificial lamb imagery and John the Baptist's witness, as explained in Catholic teaching regarding the Eucharist and Christ's role as Redeemer.

Key Meanings in Catholic Teaching:

- **Biblical Origin:** The phrase originates from John the Baptist's testimony in the Gospel of John, identifying Jesus as the one foretold who would bear the sins of the world, fulfilling prophecy.
- **Sacrificial Christ:** It emphasizes Jesus as the ultimate sacrifice (the Paschal Lamb) who, through His death, redeems humanity from sin, a concept central to Catholic theology.
- **Eucharistic Presence:** During Mass, the priest says it while showing the consecrated Host (Body of Christ), signifying that the Eucharist is the Lamb of God, present truly and substantially.
- **Invitation to Communion:** The phrase precedes the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) prayer and the invitation to receive Communion, calling the faithful to acknowledge Christ's presence and worthiness.
- **Symbol of Hope & Mercy:** The Lamb of God is also seen as leading to life-giving waters (Revelation 7:17), representing God's mercy, forgiveness and eternal hope.

In essence, "Behold, the Lamb of God" in Catholicism is a profound call to recognize Jesus' divine identity, His saving sacrifice and His real presence in the Eucharist, fostering awe and deeper communion with Him.

WAYFINDERS CATHOLIC SUMMER PROGRAM – UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

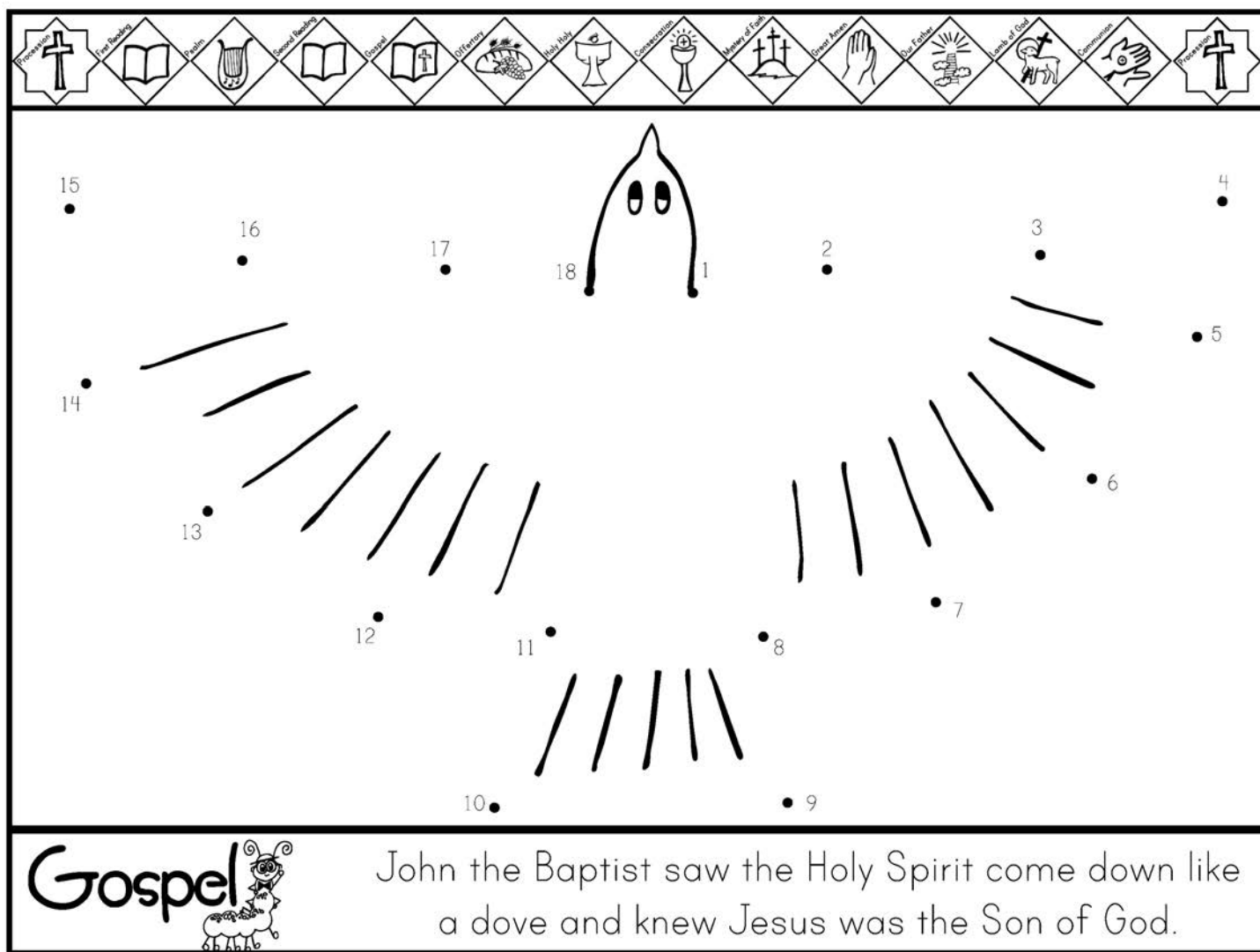
