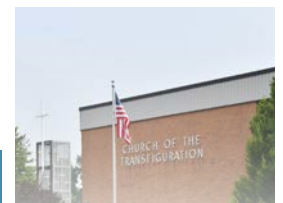

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PARISHIONER CONTACT INFO: Be sure to keep your address, phone number and e-mail up-to-date with your registered church, so you don't miss important things.

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Please don't be fooled by email scam attempts under the subject of "Our Lady of Fatima..." or from any of our priests' names. Our priests will not commonly ask for money, funds or gift cards via electronic communication.

Peace be with you. This is the fifth entry in a series where we are unpacking St. Thomas Aquinas' remedies for navigating distress and sorrow. As a refresher, those tips are pleasure, weeping, sympathy of friends, contemplating truth and taking a bath or sleeping. Last time we addressed St. Thomas' teaching and associated practical tips for seeking sympathy from friends. Today, let's look at contemplating truth. According to St. Thomas, "the greatest of all pleasures consists in the contemplation of truth." Now, truth in this case isn't whether what I'm sad about actually happened or not. Rather, for Aquinas, truth is thinking of "Divine things and of future Happiness." When we are in pain, it is easy for us to believe all hope is lost. However, when we remember what Christ has gained for us, that He has prepared a place for us in Our Father's house and that he is nearest to us in times of suffering, then our pain starts to decrease, as our pleasure in His truth takes over. When we can truly own that we are made in Love, through Love and for Love, we can rejoice knowing, "He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain any more, for the former things have passed away." God is with us always. Come and see.

ARCHDIOCESE SAFE ENVIRONMENT OFFICE UPDATE

Effective July 1, the selection.com fee for the initial online/electronic background check required for all NEW employees and volunteers will increase from \$25 to \$30.

The Safe Environment Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati continuously reviews its procedures to ensure the highest standards of child protection. In alignment with U.S.C.C.B. recommendations, we are expanding our background check protocols. In addition to the ongoing quarterly updates from the selection.com database, all electronic background checks will now require renewal every five years.

- Individuals who are SafeParish trained and have a background check older than five years will need to renew their background check.
- Those individuals will receive an email from SafeParish with detailed instructions on how to complete the renewal.
- Check Spam or Junk folders regularly.
- A \$20 fee will be charged by selection.com. In some cases, additional county clerk fees may apply.

ST. BONIFACE “CHERISH OUR HERITAGE” CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

In 2024, Beacons of Light presented the opportunity for St. Boniface deferred maintenance feasibility studies to begin including a keen review and preservation planning on how to best upkeep our properties and resources. This projected the necessity for a future giving campaign with several major maintenance projects and the buildings reaching a point of dire need.

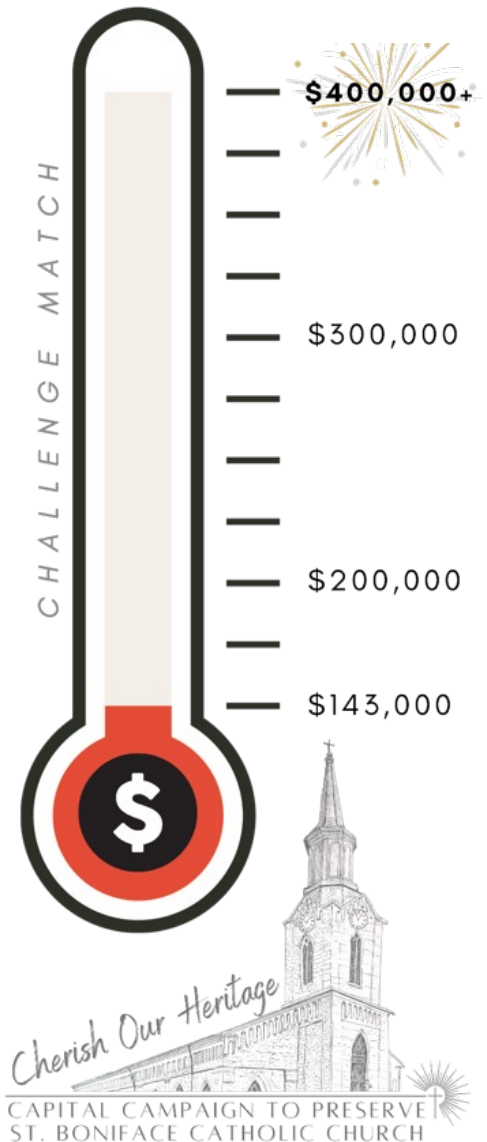
The St. Boniface maintenance crew and finance council stewarded gifts from the 2011 campaign well and tended to the surface maintenance needs of our church and property since then. **Thank you!**

But on November 1, 2025 the catastrophic boiler (HVAC) failure in church necessitated the beginning of the quiet-phase of a capital campaign to help St. Boniface. With initial giving from HVAC collections and the partnerships with donors and vendors' gifts-in-kind, more than \$140,000 was preliminarily raised.

NOW – A Legacy Committee formed, in partnership with Fr. Eric and church staff, and is comprised of five philanthropic families, friends and parishioners who want to inspire the preservation of this beautiful Catholic Church of ours. The Legacy Committee pledged **AN INCREDIBLE \$140,000, DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR CHALLENGE MATCH** to inspire **up to another \$140,000 from others** to be gifted toward the St. Boniface's Cherish Our Heritage Capital Campaign! Their advocacy **AND YOURS**, their giving **AND YOURS** will make this a success in tending to the most pressing maintenance needs of our St. Boniface properties! ST. PATRICK CATHOLIC CHURCH CAPITAL PROJECT



PHASE II - CHURCH FRONT | CURRENT



The church front step railings will be installed toward the end of June. Quality control is ensuring that all pieces of the satin anodized railing system are in great condition and that assembly is cohesively handled and secured. *More information about the railings and special donors to the St. Patrick capital project coming in the near future!*



PHASE III - PARISH OFFICE FRONT | SUMMER 2026

BIG NEWS! Phase III – in addition to the original improvement plan for the parish office front walk, soffit, porch and steps – will include major improvements to the handicap ramp and a new configuration for the church sign!

ADA compliance on the ramp and door including the ramp grading, railings, repositioning of the automatic button, a rest-landing, new ADA railings, a snow-melt system and proper clearance for wheelchairs upon the door opening have all been considerations in this major project.

To keep the church open and Masses continuing at St. Patrick during this time, the Main Street and Crawford Street doors will remain open. **The handicap ramp door will not be open.** Please help notify those who utilize walkers or wheelchairs that they will need alternate Mass attendance plans during this temporary period while the church becomes even more accessible for the future. *(If a parishioner needs to discuss individual dispensation considerations, s/he may contact Fr. Eric directly.)*

Please anticipate that the side hallway and bathroom will be inaccessible for safety and to not interrupt work in the ramp door area. The downstairs/undercroft bathrooms will be utilized. Now that we have received the proper renderings, have received appropriate clearance and vendors have been secured, work will begin as early as the week of June 22.

Although Phase IV interior capital work will not occur for some time, there are interior projects that leadership are prioritizing preemptive to that. These improvements will try to be aligned at the same time as the ramp construction of Phase III. If there is to be any interruption to Mass times, it will be announced on the St. Patrick Catholic Church Facebook page and signs will be on the church doors. (If we receive enough notice, Mass changes will also be shared in the bulletin and Sunday/weekday pulpit announcements.) These interior improvements will include the installation of wooden railings to the tabernacle/altar of repose (otherwise known as the “dais”) and near the ambo to provide stability for our priests and others in the sanctuary. It will also include initial sound improvements and replacement of the loud overhead lighting mechanisms which causes much background noise.

(Separate from the capital project above, the original roof on the St. Patrick Parish Center has had terrible leaking. A new roof will be installed in June 2026. This major project has been approved by Finance Council and was presented accordingly to the Archdiocese.) Funding has been secured for the projects above, but continued tithing and support of St. Patrick remains pertinent and appreciated so that our church can remain well-maintained for decades to come.

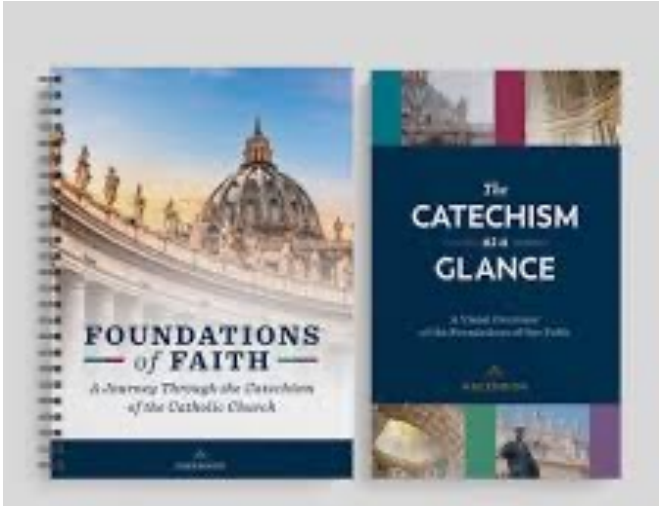

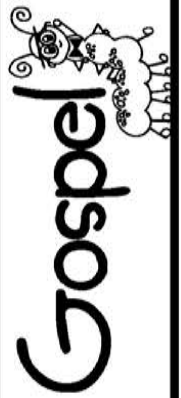
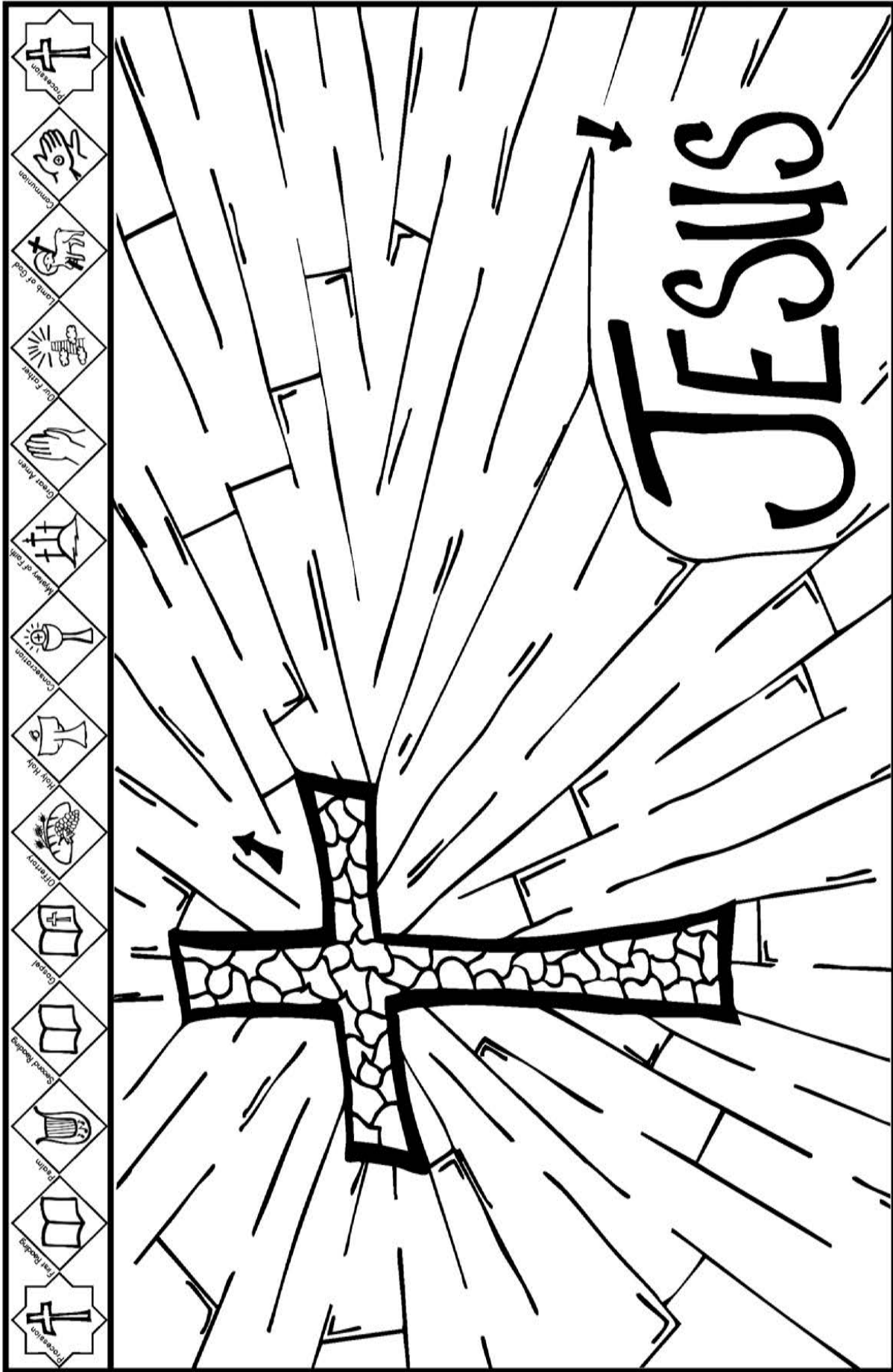
